Right Attitude?

There is a saying that says "the way we perceive something is the way we will receive it." Every time we are faced with a situation we make a choice as to how we are going to respond to it. We can look at how big our problem is or we can look at how big our Provider is. We can focus on our circumstance or we can fix our eyes on Christ. We can concentrate on our hurt or allow ourselves to be touched by The Healer. We can look at our overwhelming situation or we can look at our overcoming Saviour.

In 2 Corinthians 6, Paul starts by listing how bad his situation is "in great endurance; in troubles, hardships and distresses; in beatings, imprisonments and riots; in hard work, sleepless nights and hunger." However later in verse nine, he writes, "dying, and yet we live on; beaten, and yet not killed; sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; poor, yet making many rich; having nothing, and yet possessing everything." Paul chose to see the positive in everything that he went through. He chose to look at his situations in faith and not fear.

Sometimes when we read the Word of God the challenge seems too big, the call seems too demanding, the commission sounds like it is for someone else, but we should face these situations in a similar way to Paul, we should search for hope and seek out what good God is trying to grow in us or what truth He is wanting to teach us.
